

WHAT IS THE TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION SERVICE (TES)?

Program Description

- Evaluates student academic records to determine UC and CSU eligibility status
- Two levels of evaluation: a) automated evaluation performed by UC’s proprietary algorithm, and b) subsequent manual evaluation performed by a UC-trained evaluator
- Includes all 9th- to 12th-graders at a school
- Courses verified again through UC’s Course Management Portal (CMP), the authorized database of all approved “a-g” coursework
- Evaluation variables include all applicable subject-area validations (including by test score), dual enrollment courses, out-of-district coursework

TES Users

- Teachers and counselors
- District and school administration
- District-/school-authorized outreach programs

Support Services

- Implementation resources
- District/school staff training
- Assistance with course listing data alignment to CMP
- Designated UCOP staff to assist with questions and/or data issues

Results

Participating schools in TES see the following:

10% increase in CSU and UC eligibility after two consecutive years

32% increase for CSU and

22% increase for UC eligibility after four consecutive years

36% increase in “a-g” completion rates after four years

An increase in UC application rates **at all TES schools and districts** in relation to time in TES program
